

Heinz Faßmann

Heinz Faßmann, born 1955 in Düsseldorf, studied Geography and History in Vienna, completed a postgraduate study (Sociology) at the Institute for Advanced Studies and earned his doctorate in 1980. He finished habilitation studies in 1992 and became C4-professor of Geography and Geoinformatics at the TU Munich. He has been professor of Applied Geography, Spatial Research and Spatial Planning at the University of Vienna since 2000. He is Member of Academia Europaea and a full member of the Austrian Academy of Sciences. Moreover, he is Chairman of the Expert Council for Integration at the Federal Ministry of the Interior and member of the Expert Council of German Foundations on Integration and Migration. His research topics are: urban geography, demography (especially in the field of migration), spatial planning in Austria. He is author and editor of numerous scientific works.
