Mika Lassander is Senior Researcher in the Åbo Akademi University Centre of Excellence in Research *Young Adults and Religion in a Global Perspective* (2015–18) and in affiliated projects funded by the Academy of Finland such as *Viewpoints to the World* (2011–15). He completed his doctorate at the Open University (UK) and he is the author of *Post-Materialist Religion: Pagan Identities and Value Change in Modern Europe* (Bloomsbury, 2014) and co-editor of *Post-secular Society* (with P. Nynäs and T. Utriainen, Transaction, 2012).

Peter Nynäs is Professor of Comparative Religion at Åbo Akademi University and Director for the Centres of Excellence in Research *Post-secular Culture and a Changing Religious Landscape in Finland* (2010–14) and *Young Adults and Religion in a Global Perspective* (2015–18), funded by the Academy of Finland.
